A detector cross-section, showing particle paths

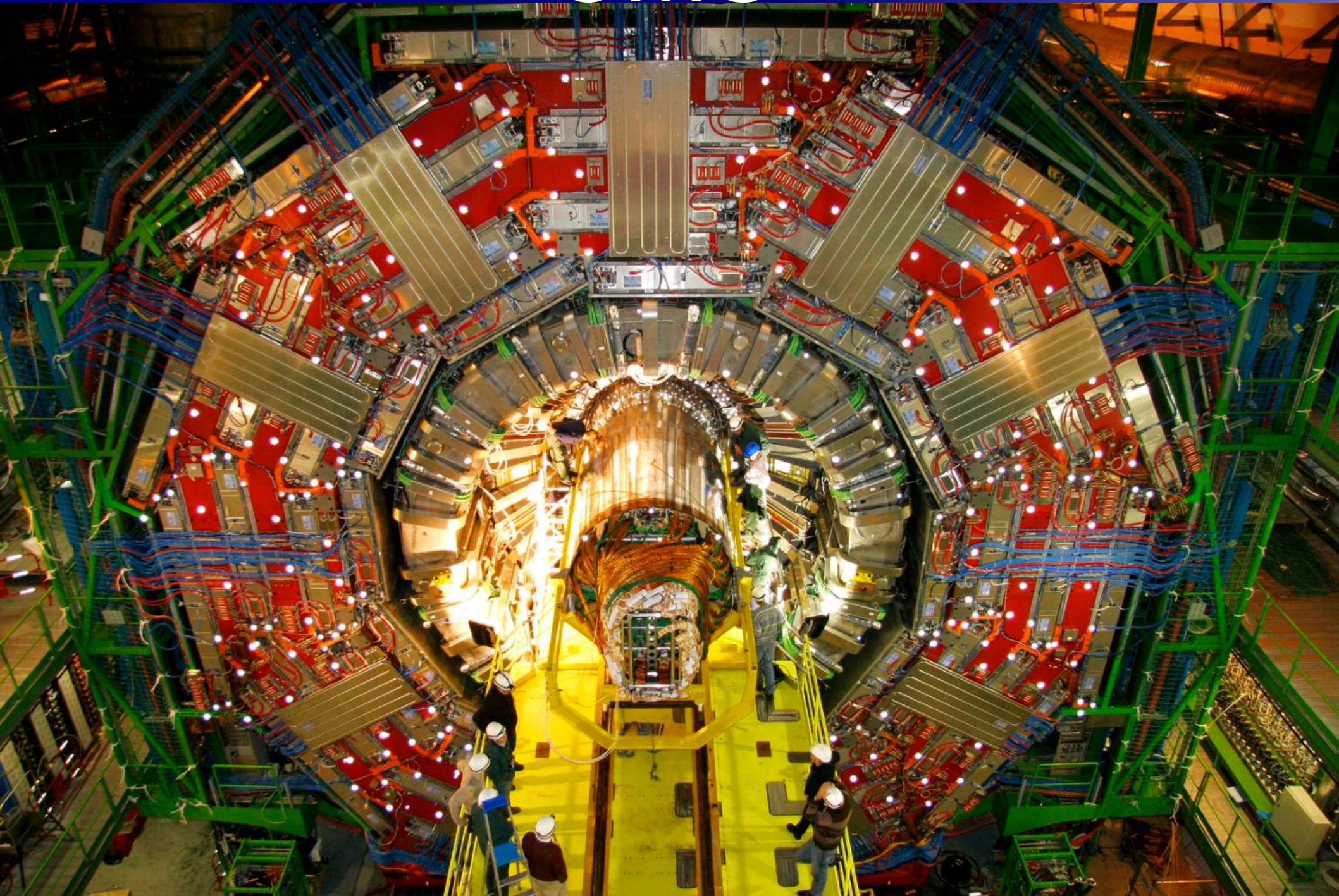
