If you are getting this by direct email then this Memo can be taken as a confirmation of your registration. Also, our registered moderators are in Cc – hello to them!

Let's go right to the latest information:

- We are two weeks from the big day!
- The Videoconferences page is now available on the [W2D2 website](#). The schedule will not be available until late next week.
- As you know, our main videoconference client for W2D2 is Zoom. In the registration form, you were prompted to suggest an alternative if you needed one. The most popular by far was Google Meet, so some of our videoconferences will use this.
- It is always best to test your videoconference connection, so we will have Zoom and Google Meet tests next week. These will be held on Fri 6 Nov. For Zoom, drop in anytime between 14:00 and 15:30 UTC on the [World Wide Data Day Zoom channel](#). (The password is "dimuon". **For security, please do not give this information out to others.**) For Google Meet, the test times are 15:30-16:30 UTC. This [time zone converter](#) can help you to translate UTC to your local time. There will be additional tests on Mon 9 Oct.
- If you signed up for a different videoconference client that Zoom or Google Meet, or if the test times given cannot work for you, please contact me.
- There have been some questions about the W2D2 measurement this year – either how to do them or how to discuss them with students.
