



W2D2 Memo #5 – almost there

Hello everyone,

In addition to W2D2 participants, we now have the moderators of our videoconferences added to this possibly final memo for World Wide Data Day 2017.

The final schedule is now available - go to the [World Wide Data Day home](#), choose the Videocons button, and scroll down. Changes at this point will be very difficult. Moderators, please note the videoconferences to which you are attached and let me know of any potential difficulties. Remember that all times are in UTC. Please take a look a little below the schedule to see the Videoconference Plan. It is helpful to be familiar with this.

With one exception*, all videoconferences are on Vidyo and all will find their link on the [W2D2 Indico page](#), which now also has its own schedule of videoconferences built in. Almost all groups have now had a successful Vidyo test and know what to do. If, however, you need last-minute help, instructions for connecting to Vidyo are in [Memo #4](#) and in the [IMC Library Vidyo page](#). In extreme circumstances, please call my telephone number below.

Videoconferences are scheduled for 30 minutes. However, where there is one videocon right after the other, we need to keep it to 25 minutes or less. It is good practice to join your videoconference about 5 minutes early to have time to establish your connection. Please enter with your microphone muted, as the previous group may still be finishing.

A few things to remind students:

- You are encouraged to tweet your World Wide Data Day experiences, #W2D2_17 and #LHCIMC18 on Twitter.
- Please think about questions for your moderators - not just about the measurements but also about, well, anything you may want to ask a particle physicist.
- Ambient noise can ruin a videoconference and microphones can be more sensitive than you think, so, during the videocon, please only speak to address the moderators. And *do* speak for that - your contributions make it great!
- We look forward to your results in the measurement. Thank you!
